Minimum Spends

There is a minimum spend required for the exclusive use of the areas at The Crabtree. The spend depends on date, time and includes all food and drink ordered by you and your guests, find out more by emailing the events manager at me5677@greeneking.co.uk

Deposits

To confirm your booking for The Rainville Room, we will take a non-refundable deposit, this will be redeemed against your bill for the event. For all other areas, we require credit card verification to secure your reservation. You will only be charged if you cancel within 48 hours or do not show up for your booking.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHY IS THERE A MINIMUM SPEND?

When we allocate a space to a function booking we forfeit that space for the use of other customers. Our minimum spend values have been determined by how much that space would make us should that space be used for usual trading on that date and time. To prevent losses we need a guarantee that the space will continue to make, at least, the minimum value that it would usually make.

ARE DOGS ALLOWED?

Of course! We allow dogs in the pub area of the building and the garden, please just ask us for a water bowl! Unfortunately, we do not allow dogs in our restaurant but we are happy to accommodate them everywhere else.

CAN WE HAVE A DEDICATED MEMBER OF STAFF TO LOOK AFTER OUR PARTY?

Of course! Just let us know when you are confirming your booking so that we can ensure we have a staff member on shift that night, specifically to look after you!

WHAT TIME ARE YOU OPEN UNTIL?

Our bar is open from 12pm-11pm Mon-Saturday, 12pm-10.30pm on Sundays. If an extension is needed, we could arrange for that for a small fee.

DO YOU ALLOW EXCLUSIVE HIRE OF THE WHOLE PUB?

Yes we do, please get in touch for more details.

IF WE DON'T HAVE A TAB AND ALL OF OUR GUESTS ARE PAYING FOR THEMSELVES HOW IS THE MINIMUM SPEND TRACKED?

All your guests have to do is mention that they are part of your party when they are at the bar and our tills will keep track of how much has been spent so far.

DO YOU NEED A DEPOSIT?

Yes, in order to secure your booking we require a deposit. Deposits vary depending based on the area, please enquire for more information.

CAN WE BOOK OUR OWN LIVE MUSIC?

Yes, no problem at all, as long as it doesn't disrupt any other guests we are happy for you to bring your own musician. We just ask that you run past us what music it is before you book, thank you. We will need to check PAT tested equipment and public liability before the event.

CAN I BRING MY OWN FOOD AND DRINK?

Unfortunately, not. Due to Health and Safety reasons, we prepare everything on site for you. We do however allow you to bring a celebratory cake for the occasion. If you wish us to store this it's not a problem!

ARE DECORATIONS ALLOWED?

Absolutely! Please feel free to decorate your area and tables however way that you wish. All we ask is that you refrain from bringing confetti or confetti filled balloons (because it's impossible to sweep it all up and we still find it weeks later) and that you only use blue-tac when pinning up banners to avoid damage to the paintwork.
