

MAKE YOUR OWN SPRINGY REINDEER

YOU WILL NEED

REINDEER TEMPLATE, WAX CRAYONS, WOBBLY
EYES, RED POM POM, SCISSORS & GLUE

STEP 1

Using a pair of scissors, cut out the shapes from the template. Ask a grown-up to help you



STEP 2

Colour in the shapes from your template



STEP 3

Glue two ends of the long strips of paper together at a right angle, and repeatedly fold them over each other to make a spring




STEP 4

Your folded spring should look like this



STEP 5

Add two wobbly eyes, a mouth and a pom pom nose to your reindeer face. Glue each end of the spring to the front and back legs to join them together

MAKE YOUR OWN SPRINGY REINDEER

YOU WILL NEED

STEP 1

STEP 2

Colour in the shapes from your template



STEP 3

Glue two ends of the long strips of paper together at a right angle, and repeatedly fold them over each other to make a spring




STEP 4

Your folded spring should look like this



STEP 5

Add two wobbly eyes, a mouth and a pom pom nose to your reindeer face. Glue each end of the spring to the front and back legs to join them together

MAKE YOUR OWN

FESTIVE PAPER CHAINS

YOU WILL NEED

COLOURED PAPER, PENS, FESTIVE
SHAPES/DECORATIONS, SCISSORS & GLUE

STEP 1

Using a pair of scissors, cut long strips of coloured paper. Ask a grown-up to help you



STEP 2

Bend one of the strips into a loop and secure with glue



STEP 3

Thread the next strip through the first loop and secure with glue to make another loop



STEP 4

Repeat until you are happy with the length of your paper chain



STEP 5

Add a festive decoration to your paper chain!

MAKE YOUR OWN

FESTIVE PAPER CHAINS

YOU WILL NEED

COLOURED PAPER, PENS, FESTIVE SHAPES/DECORATIONS, SCISSORS & GLUE

STEP 1

Using a pair of scissors, cut long strips of coloured paper. Ask a grown-up to help you



STEP 2

Bend one of the strips into a loop and secure with glue



STEP 3

Thread the next strip through the first loop and secure with glue to make another loop



STEP 4

Repeat until you are happy with the length of your paper chain



STEP 5

Add a festive decoration to your paper chain!

YOU WILL NEED

WHITE CARD, BROWN PAPER, COLOURED TISSUE
PAPER, CRAYONS, STAR STICKERS, SCISSORS & GLUE

STEP 1

Fold a piece
of coloured
card in half
and add some
snowflakes
to your card
using crayons



STEP 2

Using a pair of
scissors, cut
out a brown
tree trunk
shape and glue
it to your card.
Ask a grown-up
to help you



STEP 3

Make small balls
of tissue paper
and glue them to
the card in the
shape of a tree



STEP 4

Add a star
sticker to the
top of your
tree!

YOU WILL NEED

WHITE CARD, BROWN PAPER, COLOURED TISSUE
PAPER, CRAYONS, STAR STICKERS, SCISSORS & GLUE

Fold a piece
of coloured
card in half
and add some
snowflakes
to your card
using crayons



STEP 2

Using a pair of
scissors, cut
out a brown
tree trunk
shape and glue
it to your card.

MAKE YOUR OWN HANDPRINT RUDOLPH

YOU WILL NEED

WHITE CARD, BROWN PAINT, CRAYONS, WOBBLY EYES, POM POMS AND GLUE

STEP 1

Use the brown paint to add two handprints to the white card facing opposite ways



STEP 2

Add a pom pom nose and a wobbly eye to the upright handprint



STEP 3

Use a crayon to draw a mouth on Rudolph's face



STEP 4

Draw some hooves on Rudolph's legs



STEP 5

Add a pom pom collar to Rudolph's neck

MAKE YOUR OWN HANDPRINT RUDOLPH

YOU WILL NEED

WHITE CARD, BROWN PAINT, CRAYONS,
WOBBLY EYES, POM POMS AND GLUE

STEP 1

Use the brown paint to add two handprints to the white card facing opposite ways



STEP 2

Add a pom pom nose and a wobbly eye to the upright handprint



STEP 3

Use a crayon to draw a mouth on Rudolph's face



STEP 4

Draw some hooves on Rudolph's legs



STEP 5

Add a pom pom collar to Rudolph's neck


MAKE YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS LIGHTS GARLAND

a pipe cleaner




STEP 2





MAKE YOUR OWN SANTA STICKS

YOU WILL NEED

WOODEN LOLLIPOP STICKS, WHITE TISSUE PAPER, STRING, A BLACK PEN, RED PAINT, SCISSORS & GLUE

STEP 1

Paint the bottom half of the lollipop stick red



STEP 2

Add two eyes and a tissue paper beard



STEP 3

Paint a red hat at the top of your Santa Stick and add a black belt across the middle



STEP 4

Using a pair of scissors, cut a length of string. Ask a grown-up to help you



STEP 5

Attach the string to the top of the stick so you can hang it from your Christmas tree!

MAKE YOUR OWN SANTA STICKS

YOU WILL NEED

WOODEN LOLLIPOP STICKS, WHITE TISSUE PAPER, STRING, A BLACK PEN, RED PAINT, SCISSORS & GLUE

STEP 1

Paint the bottom half of the lollipop stick red



STEP 2

Add two eyes and a tissue paper beard



STEP 3

Paint a red hat at the top of your Santa Stick and add a black belt across the middle



STEP 4

Using a pair of scissors, cut a length of string. Ask a grown-up to help you



STEP 5

Attach the string to the top of the stick so you can hang it from your Christmas tree!


MAKE YOUR OWN BEADED CANDY CANE

YOU WILL NEED

PIPE CLEANER, RED & WHITE
BEADS, STRING AND SCISSORS

STEP 1

Thread red and white beads
onto a pipe cleaner



STEP 2

Bend one end of the pipe cleaner to make
a candy cane shape and twist the ends
to stop the beads falling off



STEP 3

Using a pair of scissors, cut a piece of string.
Ask a grown-up to help you



STEP 4

Tie the string to the top of the candy cane
to make a hanger. You could use it to
decorate your tree


MAKE YOUR OWN BEADED CANDY CANE
