


THE DISCOVERY BAR

We are delighted to reintroduce and feature wines from Bolney Wine Estate, known for producing some of the highest quality English wines. Nestled in the heart of rural Sussex, the beautiful Bolney Estate offers a true taste of English viticulture.

Established in 1972, Bolney Wine Estate was one of the first English wine estates and has played a significant role in shaping the burgeoning English wine industry. The founders, guided by nature, discovered the ideal varieties of grapes to cultivate in the mild climate and sandstone soil ecosystem of Sussex.

Today, Bolney Wine Estate's team of wine experts continues to embody the founding ethos, producing award-winning still and sparkling wines. From the renowned Pinot Noir and Pinot Gris to the classic sparkling Bolney Bubbly and Blanc de Blancs, Bolney is synonymous with quality wine crafted in a contemporary style.

BRIGHTON BIER

As the city's original craft brewery, Brighton Bier is an international award-winning craft brewery that is rooted in the local community, with events, bierhaus venues and an enviable roster of local ales that make them a firm favourite in Brighton and the surrounding area.



Recommendation

Brighton Bier Pilsner – 5.1

BRIGHTON GIN

Brighton Gin was founded in 2012 by Kathy Caton MBE and epitomises the Spirit of Brighton: unusual, fun-loving, open-minded, fiercely independent, and ethically conscious. Based at the city's first (legal!) distillery, it produces premium, multi-award-winning Brighton Gin in small batches entirely by hand, a stone's throw away from the sea.



Recommendation

The Sussex 75 Brighton Gin, lime juice & Sussex sparkling wine, garnished with a lemon peel – 12

BOLNEY WINE ESTATE

Established in 1972 by English wine pioneers Janet and Rodney Pratt, Bolney Wine Estate in West Sussex was one of the first, and remains one of the most beautiful, English wine estates. The team produce award-winning still and sparkling wines from their famous Pinot Noir and Pinot Gris to classic sparkling Bolney Bubbly and Blanc de Blancs.



Recommendation

Lychgate Rosé 2020 – 35

BURNING SKY BREWERY

A true farmhouse brewery, nestled in the shadow of the South Downs, in Firlé, Burning Sky produces hop-forward pale ales and Belgian-style “saisons”. They were the first craft brewery in the UK to install oak “foudres” for ageing beers – barrels which gives their delightful creations the unique profile that make these artisan brewers so loved.



Recommendation

Burning Sky Arise Pale Ale – 6.1

DITCHLING SPIRITS

Nestled in the foothills of the South Downs, Ditchling is an idyllic village, bustling with creative energy and community spirit. Inspired by the history of the local Arts and Crafts movement and drawing on a tradition of foraging the South Downs, Ditchling Spirits use local ingredients and artisan suppliers to create drinks imbued with a unique sense of place.



Recommendation

Ditchling Negroni Ditchling East Sussex Gin, Campari, Martini Rosso, stirred gently and topped with an orange wedge – 12

GOLDSTONE RUM

Goldstone Rum is a multi-award-winning Sussex distillery making exceptional British rums from scratch. Locally produced, artisan products using the highest quality ingredients, Goldstone combines four unprocessed sugars and all natural fruits and spices to add a distinctive, refined flavour to their rums – fermented, distilled and bottled right here in Sussex.

Recommendation

Goldstone Mojito Goldstone Rum, lime juice, sugar, mint & soda water, capped with a wedge of lime – 12



HARLEY HOUSE

Harley House is a family run distillery located in Seaford, East Sussex. It prides itself on creating unique hand-produced small batch produce that showcases the local area and leaves a lasting memory on the tastebuds. Using water direct from their aquifer which has been filtered through the South Downs in every batch, creates the purest beginning of any spirit.

Recommendation

Prohibition Punch Harley House Prohibition Rum & lime juice topped with fiery Fever-Tree Ginger Ale – 12



HARVEY'S BREWERY

Harvey's Brewery is the oldest independent brewery in Sussex and has been in the guardianship of seven generations of John Harvey's descendants since 1790. Using a blend of four local hops, water filtered through the Sussex Downs for 30 years and Harvey's unique 60-year-old yeast strain, Harvey's Best Bitter is the embodiment of Sussex.

Recommendation

Harvey's Sussex Best Bitter (Draught) (4.0%)



LONG MAN BREWERY

Creating 'Naturally Excellent Beers' in a converted flint barn in the heart of the South Downs, Long Man put sustainability at the core of everything. Barley regeneratively grown on site, brewing with solar power and water drawn from their own borehole, and recycling as much waste as possible puts flavour in step with nature, from grain to glass.

Recommendation

Long Blonde Ale (Draught) (3.8%)



MADAME JENNIFER DISTILLERY

An urban small-batch distillery, making premium gin, vodka, and fine liqueurs. Located in Poet's Corner in the heart of Hove, Madame Jennifer was created by husband-and-wife Inger and Ian, who trained as a chemist and biologist, before turning their training to more palatable pursuits.

Recommendation

Limoncello – 6.1



SPIRIT OF THE DOWNS

Multi-award-winning, sustainable producer of small batch Brandies, Grape Spirit and Vodka, Spirit of the Downs use grapes from the finest English sparkling wine producers around the South Downs. Each spirit captures the season it was created, the unique territory of the local vineyard and the grape varietal chosen.

Recommendation

Brandy, Chardonnay Vintage 2021,
English oaked grapes from Sugrue
South Downs – 7.1



UNBARRED BREWERY

Founded from a shed in Hove and now based in central Brighton, UnBarred Brewery was born from a love of brewing uncompromising and exciting beers inspired by the uniquely bohemian and creative nature of their local community. From beer conception to design and brewing UnBarred collaborates with local artists, independent businesses, and creatives to showcase Brighton's vibrant culture at its best.

Recommendation

Joosy Hazy Pale Ale (5.1%)
