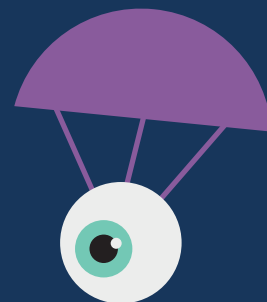


MAKE YOUR OWN HANDPRINT BATS



▶ YOU WILL NEED ◀

Printable bat template, coloured paper, wobbly eyes, wax crayon, scissors & glue

STEP 1

Place a piece of coloured card beneath the template and using a pair of scissors, cut out the shapes from the template. Ask a grown-up to help you.



STEP 2

Trace around your hand twice using a wax crayon.



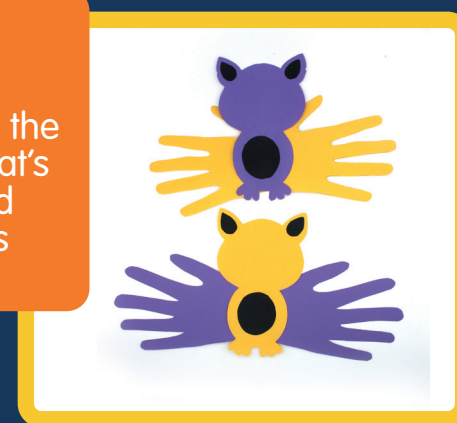
STEP 3

Using a pair of scissors, cut out the handprints. Ask a grown-up to help you.



STEP 4

Glue your handprints to the back of the bat's body and add the inner ears and tummy.



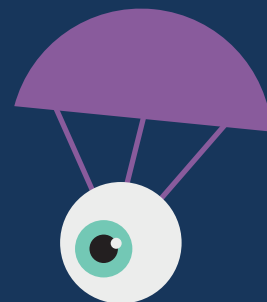
STEP 5

Draw the bat's mouth with a wax crayon and add two wobbly eyes to create your handprint bat!

Printable bat template, coloured paper, wobbly eyes, wax crayon, scissors & glue

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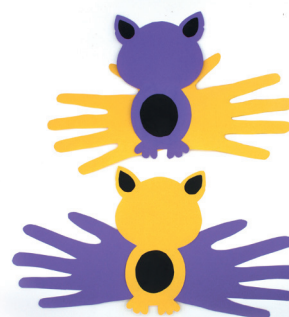

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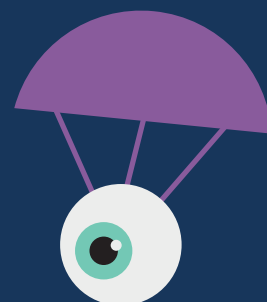
STEP 5

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MAKE YOUR OWN HANGING PUMPKINS



▶ YOU WILL NEED ◀

Printable pumpkin template, crayons,
string, scissors & glue

STEP 1

Colour in your
pumpkin template
using crayons.



STEP 2

Using a pair of
scissors, cut out
the shapes from
your template.

Ask a grown-up
to help you.



STEP 3

Glue the ends
indicated 'T' together,
followed by the ends
indicated 'B'.



STEP 4

Roll up a thin
strip of brown
paper into a curl
and glue it to the top
of the pumpkin,
alongside the
leaf shapes.



STEP 5

Glue a length of
string to the top
of your hanging
pumpkin.

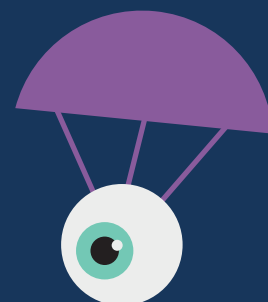

MAKE YOUR OWN BAT HEADBAND

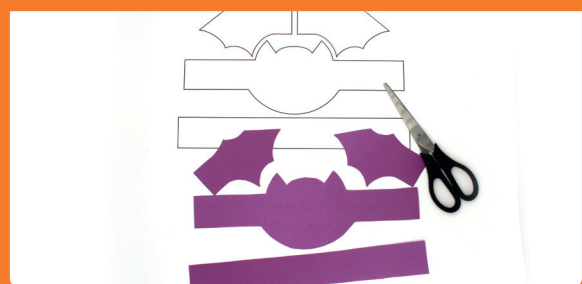


▶▶ YOU WILL NEED ◀◀

Printable bat template, coloured paper, wobbly eyes, wax crayon, scissors & glue

STEP 1

Place a piece of coloured card beneath the template and using a pair of scissors, cut out the shapes from the template. Ask a grown-up to help you.



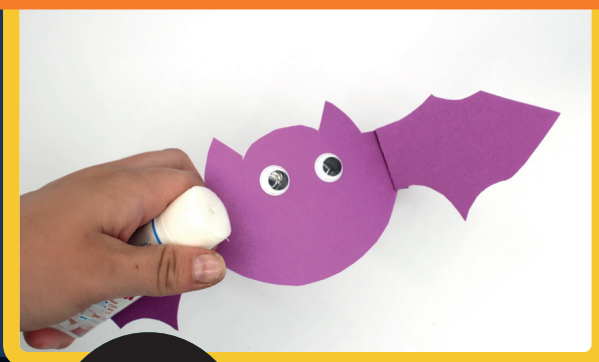
STEP 2

STEP 3

Glue two wobbly eyes to the bat's face.



STEP 4

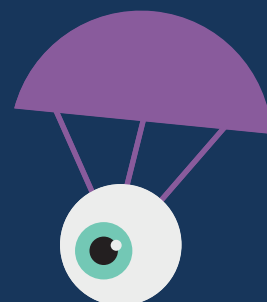
Add the bat's mouth and fangs to the headband using pens/paint.

MAKE YOUR OWN BAT HEADBAND

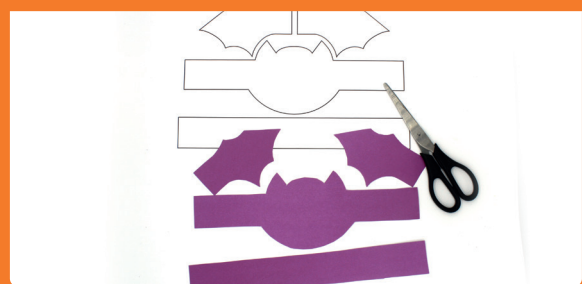

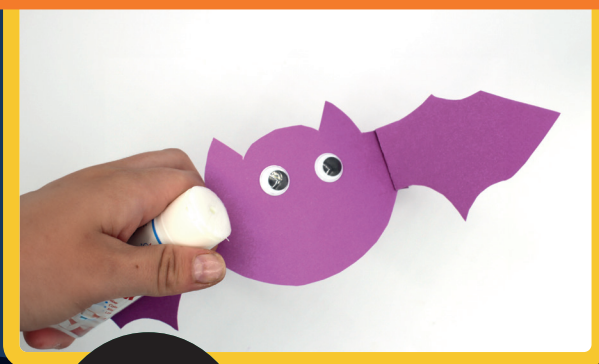
STEP 2

STEP 4

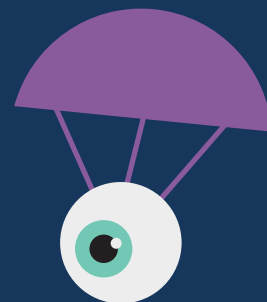
Add the bat's mouth and fangs to the headband using pens/paint.

MAKE YOUR OWN HALLOWEEN LANTERNS



▶ YOU WILL NEED ◀

Printable lantern template, pens/paint, scissors & glue

STEP 1

Colour in both sides of the template using pens/paints.



STEP 2

Using a pair of scissors, cut out the shapes from the template.

Ask a grown-up to help you.



STEP 3

Using a pair of scissors, cut along the inner lines of the larger rectangle.

Ask a grown-up to help you.



STEP 4

Glue the two opposite edges of the paper together and add the handle to the top to make the lantern.



STEP 5

Add eye and mouth shapes to your lantern to make a face!

MAKE YOUR OWN HALLOWEEN LANTERNS



▶ YOU WILL NEED ◀

Printable lantern template, pens/paint, scissors & glue

STEP 1

Colour in both sides of the template using pens/paints.



STEP 2

Using a pair of scissors, cut out the shapes from the template.

Ask a grown-up to help you.



STEP 3

Using a pair of scissors, cut along the inner lines of the larger rectangle.

Ask a grown-up to help you.



STEP 4

Glue the two opposite edges of the paper together and add the handle to the top to make the lantern.



STEP 5

Add eye and mouth shapes to your lantern to make a face!

MAKE YOUR OWN PAPER PUMPKINS

▶ YOU WILL NEED ◀

Coloured paper, pipe cleaners,
scissors & glue



STEP 1

Using a pair of scissors, cut out four long strips of paper.

Ask a grown-up to help you.



STEP 2

Bend the first strip around to create a ring.



STEP 3

Thread the remaining strips through the first ring and glue at the top to create a ball.



STEP 4

Add a curled pipe cleaner to the stalk of the pumpkin.



STEP 5

Roll up a thin strip of brown paper into a tube and cut slits at the bottom. Glue it to the top of the pumpkin to make the stalk.

MAKE YOUR OWN PAPER PUMPKINS

▶ YOU WILL NEED ◀

Coloured paper, pipe cleaners,
scissors & glue



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Add a curled pipe cleaner to the stalk of the pumpkin.



STEP 5

Roll up a thin strip of brown paper into a tube and cut slits at the bottom. Glue it to the top of the pumpkin to make the stalk.



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MAKE YOUR OWN MONSTER FACES



▶▶ YOU WILL NEED ◀◀

Printable monster face template, coloured paper, wobbly eyes, scissors & glue

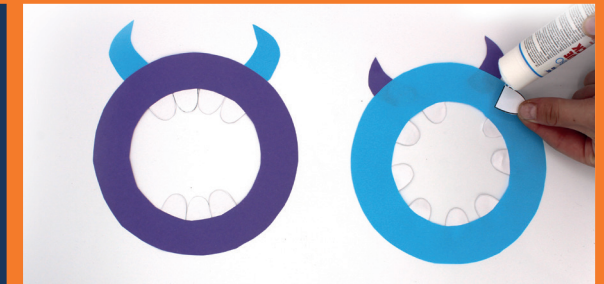
STEP 1

Place a piece of coloured card beneath the template and using a pair of scissors, cut out the shapes from the template. Ask a grown-up to help you.



STEP 2

Glue the teeth to the inner circle, and glue the horns to the top of the outer circle.



STEP 3

Glue some wobbly eyes to the top of the circle.



STEP 4

Enjoy your Wacky monster face!

Printable monster face template, coloured paper, wobbly eyes, scissors & glue

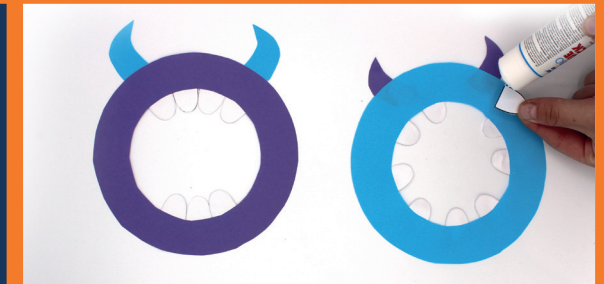
STEP 1

Glue the teeth to the inner circle, and glue the horns to the top of the outer circle.



STEP 3

Glue some wobbly eyes to the top of the circle.
